It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Dr. Philip Low, Co-Founder and Chief Scientific Officer of Eradivir on March 4, 2026.

Dr. Low was a pioneering scientist and entrepreneur whose work helped shape the field of next-generation targeted therapeutics. As a Presidential Scholar in Drug Discovery and Ralph C. Corley Distinguished Professor of Chemistry at Purdue University, he authored hundreds of scientific publications, held numerous patents, and founded several biotechnology companies dedicated to bringing innovative therapies to patients.

At Eradivir, Dr. Low's research laid the foundation for our antibody-recruiting small molecule technology, and his leadership, insight, and mentorship profoundly shaped our mission and team.
